

Shayne's Roundup Match 2133

ROUNDUP was brought to the GWF by Shayne in 2133. He uses this match to determine the number one contender to whichever championship he is holding.

There is no ring. The match takes place, usually on Earth, in a large horse corral surrounded by a sturdy wooden fence. Instead of referees, rodeo clowns surround the ring and they may get involved in the match!

The object: Be the last competitor standing in the middle of the corral. Eliminations occur when a wrestler is thrown over the top rail of the corral to the dirt floor outside the corral.

ROUNDUP uses an 'open door challenge' policy that was popularized by a professional wrestling promotion on Earth during the 21st Century. This means any and all wrestlers, managers that can wrestle, wrestlers from other feds or athletes from other sports can take part and try to become number one contender!

Use Universal Battle Royal Rules

- No one is allowed at ringside.

Substitute "whip into fence post - 3" for "into the ropes" and "into the turnbuckle"

-When a wrestler is thrown out of the ring, roll one die. If the result is a 1, one of the Rodeo Clowns at ringside catches the wrestler and throws the wrestler back in the ring! The wrestler is not eliminated!

The winner of the match faces Shayne later on in the evening for the title. In some instances, Shayne will demand the match start as soon as the winner is declared!
